## Payment and Location

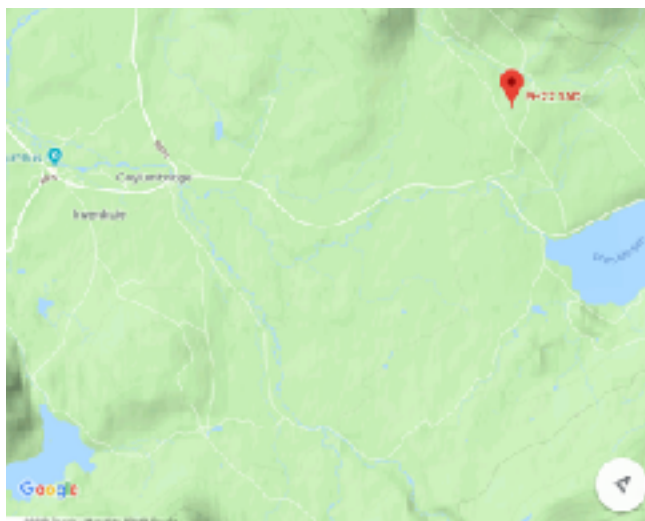
### Payment

Camp costs are tiered for families. A first child costs £225, with additional siblings costing £195. Please send first this booking form to the address overleaf. Once your booking is confirmed we will send out an invoice for the camp fee. PLEASE ONLY SEND PAYMENT WHEN BOOKING IS CONFIRMED.

**Fees** received before April 21st are reduced by £10 per camper. Bookings must be returned by **31 May**. **Later** bookings are subject to a late booking fee of £25 per camper.
