

LOCATION & DIRECTIONS

The venue for the 2022 Conference is the Westhill Church, Culloden Road, Westhill, Inverness, IV2 5BP (approximately 200 yards east of the Inverness city boundary). The following directions may be of help:

From the North

Follow the A9 south to Inverness. Cross the Kessock Bridge and at the roundabout take the second exit (continuing on the A9). Follow A9 for approximately 3.9 miles to Culloden Road. Follow B9006 for approximately 2.6 miles to Westhill. Westhill Church is on the right, set back from the road.

From the South

Follow the A9 north towards Inverness. Follow the B851. Continue on B851 for approximately 4.5 miles to Westhill. Westhill Church is on the right, set back from the road.

From the East

Follow the A96 west towards Inverness. Turn left onto B9006 and continue for approximately 0.4 miles. Continue onto Old Military Road/B9090 for approximately 1.0 miles. Turn right onto B9091 and continue for approximately 1.5 miles. Continue onto B9006 for approximately 5.7 miles. Turn right for a short distance and then turn left. Westhill Church is on the right, set back from the road.

From the West

Follow the A82 to Culloden Road. Follow B9006 for approximately 2.6 miles to Westhill. Westhill Church is on the right, set back from the road.

SPEAKERS

REV. JOHN W. KEDDIE is a retired minister and Seminary lecturer of the Free Church of Scotland (Continuing). Born and brought up in Edinburgh he trained and worked as a professional accountant before he trained for the Free Church ministry, into which he was ordained in 1987. He served pastorates in Burghead (Morayshire), and Bracadale (Isle of Skye), adhering to the Free Church of Scotland (Continuing) in 2000. Mr Keddie lectured in Church History & Principles in the Free Church Seminary (2008-2019). He is the author of several books, notably one on the history of the Free Church of Scotland in the 20th century and an account of the division of 2000. His popular biography of Eric Liddell (*Running the Race*) has had a wide circulation in English and Chinese since 2007. Mr Keddie has been married to Jean since 1971 and they have four adult children and eleven grandchildren.

REV. TREVOR KIRKLAND was born into a farming family in Co. Antrim. He studied for an honours degree prior to going into the ministry. In 2002 he was appointed to the Committee of the Trinitarian Bible Society and he is a founder member of its Northern Ireland Committee. Following more than twenty years in the ministry he was admitted into the Free Church of Scotland (Continuing) and presently ministers in the Ballyclare & Doagh congregation, north of Belfast. In 2019 he was appointed Lecturer in Church History & Church Principles in the Free Church Seminary. He is married to Diane and they have four adult children.
